- a. Solicitation Strategic Planning – No Update Until July Mtg**

Background: On March 10, 2026, the District announced a solicitation for proposals to engage qualified consultants tasked with developing a new Strategic Business Plan aimed at enhancing transit services, diversifying funding sources, and modernizing business practices over the next three to five years. This comprehensive plan is intended to provide a roadmap for the Board and leadership, guiding program management, development, external communications, outreach integration, and internal capacity building. Following the solicitation, the District received six proposals from interested consultants.

Director Thompson and Director Johnson are on the evaluation committee.

Area Transit District (CCATD) consider redistricting to incorporate Curry County, a move that underscores the importance of consolidating transit services for enhanced sustainability and continuity along the southern Oregon coast. This initiative aims to streamline operations and improve service offerings by returning to a shared governance model reminiscent of the 1980s and 1990s, which aligns more closely with current transit patterns. Established as an independent municipal corporation, CCATD was designed to enhance administrative efficiency in navigating complex grant cycles, and this annexation is in line with its Transit Master Plan to foster better coordination with rural services. By integrating the two areas, the proposal promises to create a critical core of transportation services that meets the needs of the region more effectively.

8. NEW BUSINESS

a. ODOT 5339 Agreement 35681

Background: As of June 4, 2026, the District faces a critical funding challenge regarding the Transit Center project. Although we have a contract in place, there is currently no mechanism in place to invoice and accrue the land acquisition expenses against the federal 5339 grant (Agreement 35681) as ODOT has not opened the invoice portal. While the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has provided gap relief by granting access to the

STIFD 35896 grant award to address immediate cash flow needs, the lack of an established process to allocate expenses to the federal project poses a significant risk to the overall viability of the Transit Center Project. Without the ability to accrue these costs against the federal funding stream we will deplete our non federal STIFD 35896 grant which was earmarked to meet matching requirements on the project. The District has no other mechanism to meet our non-federal matching requirements on the project. This precarious financial situation underscores the urgency of resolving the accrual issue prior to June 30, 2026 to ensure the project's success and sustainability.

I sent emails to ODOT on May 6, 2026, May 13, 2026, and June 2, 2026 and have spoken with Jennifer numerous times.

b. Personnel Manual

Background: The last full review of CCATD Personnel Manual was in January 2025. The bulk of the changes included incorporating health insurance, adjusting holidays so we are better aligned with our neighboring transit districts, and incorporation of law changes. Through SDAO we have preferred pricing with HR Answers. We customized the template provided by HR Answers and HR Answers reviewed the entire manual.

c. Drug & Alcohol Testing Policy

Background: The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requires employers that receive financial assistance from the FTA and by contractors of those employers, to implement programs, as specified in 49 CFR Part 655, that are designed to help prevent accidents, injuries, and fatalities resulting from the misuse of alcohol and use of prohibited drugs by employees who perform safety-sensitive functions.

In May 2026 there was a change in the law changing the term gender to sex which triggered RLS to send out a new policy template.

The updated Coos County Transportation District Drug and Alcohol Policy consists of the template provided by RLS, ODOT Drug & Alcohol compliance contractor, and meets all the FTA requirements.
