c. Super Stop Update and Architectural Agreement – R. Jennings

Background: In July 2020, CCATD was awarded \$139.983 grant with a commitment of the district to match \$34,996 with a vision to establish a Super Stop to accommodate three buses and include the purchase and installation of a shelter near the North Bend Veteran's Center. The grant has been extended and now sunsets December 31, 2023.

The Veteran's Center has contracted with Crow/Clay for designing the building expansion project of 5,544SF. The Super Stop is being incorporated into the planned expansion. Crow/Clay has provided the attached architectural service agreement for the design and preparation of construction documents, plans and specifications for the Super Stop.

d. Fitness for Duty for Safety Sensitive Positions

Background: Coos County Area Transportation District is committed to continue to improve the safety and security of CCATD's operation and services for its employees, customers, the public, property, and the environment. Said operation is possible only when each employee can perform his or her job duties in a safe, secure, and effective manner, and remains able to do so throughout the entire time they are working. Employees who are not fit for duty may present a safety risk to themselves and to others.

To facilitate fitness for duty for safety sensitive positions, staff have reviewed and updated job descriptions clarifying essential job duties, established a preemployment requirement of a Fitness Test, drafted a policy to clarify when a referral for an independent fitness for duty is necessary, and a policy to establish procedures to return to work following an extended period.
